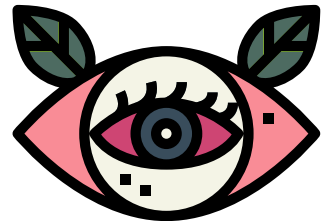
OUR YOUNG LEARNERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO ...



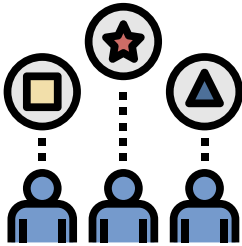
...learn using digital tools, and develop smart ways to use them safely and effectively

...know how to respect and look after our bodies (e.g eye breaks, posture etc) when we use digital tools



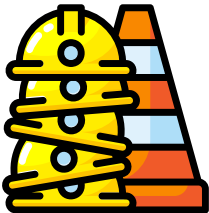
...learn that people make the tech and people can break, remake, hack, create the spaces we use online
